NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, April 8, 2026, at 1:00 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and/or act on the following matters:


1. Public comments;
2. Approval of minutes of the meeting of the Board of Directors held March 11, 2026;
3. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented and approving moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
5. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
6. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing an Additional Penalty on Delinquent Real Property Taxes and authorize the delinquent tax attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent real property taxes beginning July 1, 2026, including the filing of lawsuits, as necessary;
7. Engineering Report, including:
  - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction of facilities within the District, and/or ratification of same, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, including:
    - i) Water Supply Plant No. 1 Electrical System Improvements; and
    - ii) Sidewalk project;
  - (b) Status of construction contracts, including the approval of any pay estimates, change orders and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, including:
    - i) Water Supply Plant No. 1 Phase 4 by Gilleland Smith Construction, Inc.; and
    - ii) Coe and Wright Roads Waterline Extensions by ISJ Underground Utilities;
  - (c) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District;
  - (d) Acceptance of conveyances of facilities;

- (e) Status of Decker Lake Dam, Decker Dry Detention Dam and Goodson Branch Dam safety repairs pursuant to TCEQ Dam Safety Inspection Reports and authorize any action necessary in connection with same, including:
    - i) Status of Emergency Action Plan and Operation and Maintenance Plan for Decker Lake Dam filed with the TCEQ on behalf of the District;
  - (f) Discussion regarding Capital Improvement Plan;
  - (g) Status of GIS for the District;
  - (h) Status of renewal of Wastewater Treatment Plant Permit; and
  - (i) Requests for utility commitments, out-of-district service, and/or annexation;
8. Storm Water Management Program;
  9. Report from Environmental Allies, including:
    - (a) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
    - (b) Status of installation of signage within the District to deter vehicular traffic in unauthorized areas of the District; and
    - (c) Approve Second Amendment to contract;
  10. Operator's Report, including:
    - (a) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
    - (b) Compliance with District's water and waste discharge permits;
    - (c) Appeals of District charges;
    - (d) Refer accounts for collection and approve write-offs;
    - (e) Status of installation of surge protection equipment;
    - (f) Approval of 2025 water loss audit and authorize filing of same with Texas Water Development Board;
    - (g) Status of filing water conservation plan annual implementation report; and
    - (h) Operator's annual report regarding status of the District's Identity Theft Prevention Program ("Program"), including discussion of Program compliance, staff training, effectiveness and suggested changes;
  11. Amendment of the District's Rate Order, including but not limited to, the adjustment of residential sanitary sewer rates associated with the Consumer Price Index increase imposed by Best Trash, LLC;
  12. Discuss requirements for the EPA's final National Primary Drinking Water Regulation concerning PFAS and testing schedule for same;
  13. Adoption of Rules and Regulations Governing Sewer House Lines and Sewer Connections and Notice relative to same;
  14. Homeowner Association matters;

- 17. Matters for possible placement on future agendas.
