NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District. The meeting will be held on **Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.** **Members of the public may attend the meeting via telephone conference by dialing +1 469-998-7488, and entering pin 920924445#.** The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:
