 - a. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service;
 - b. approve and authorize operator to file water loss audit; and
 - c. conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
7. Maintenance of District facilities.
8. Development report.
9. Terminate Municipal Advisory Services Agreement with Robert W. Baird & Co. Incorporated and engage Cedar Creek Municipal Advisors, LLC as the District's Financial Advisor.
10. Reports from Directors and District consultants and meeting schedule.
