4. Tax assessment and collections matters, including payment of tax bills, installment agreements, delinquent tax collections, depository pledge agreements, and requests for estimates of taxable value.
5. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, maintenance, proposals for certain improvements, and amendment of Rate Order.
6. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and for damages or theft of District facilities or services and authorize termination of service.
7. Conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
8. Approve and authorize operator to file water loss audit.
9. City of Houston industrial user permitting matters.
10. Maintenance of detention ponds and District facility sites, including proposals for additional work.
11. Engineering matters, including authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate, for the following:
  - a. water plant no. 1 canopy installation for chemical tanks;
  - b. water well no. 3;
  - c. next phase of District facilities;
  - d. capital improvement plan;
  - e. proposals for engineering services; and
  - f. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, access agreements, pipeline crossing reimbursement and encroachment agreements, requests for service, utility commitment letters, and appraisals.
