

NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 503

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 503 will hold a regular meeting on Monday, June 1, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Sabine Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

5. Authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.

 - a. amend Rate Order, if necessary;
 - b. billings, repairs, and maintenance;
 - c. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service; and
 - d. approve Consumer Confidence Report and authorize operator to deliver Consumer Confidence Report and file certificate of delivery with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
8. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. service agreements, submerged storm sewer agreements, preparation and approval of plans and specifications, advertisement for bids, bid review, contract award or termination, pay estimates and change orders, substantial completion, final acceptance of facilities, and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facilities, as appropriate, including for the sanitary sewer extension;
 - b. report on grade separation at Union Pacific Railroad and intersection improvements at Highway 290; and
 - c. accept or grant conveyance of deeds and easements and approve consents to encroachment, rights of entry, abandonment or assignment of easements, including report from special counsel.
9. Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 500 (Master) matters.
10. West Harris County Regional Water Authority Matters.
