HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 365

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 365 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, June 15, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, **Suite 2400, Rio Grande Room**, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event, the item will be removed and placed on the Regular Agenda.

1. Approve minutes.
2. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
4. Operator's report of District water, sanitary sewer, and stormwater facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance.

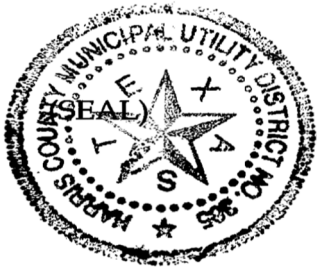

 - a. update on federal grant application, associated costs, timeline for implementation, and related matters;
 - b. environmental and engineering service matters; and
 - c. update on design.
9. Additional bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. authorize submittal of joint facilities budget to Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 364; and
 - b. approve Amended and Restated Agreement for Bookkeeping Services.
10. Review District insurance proposals and authorize renewal of policies.
11. Additional operating matters, including:
 - a. authorize operator to send uncollectable accounts to collection agency; and
 - b. customer contact log.


12. Hearing on termination of water service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
13. Additional tax assessment and collection matters, including:
 - a. review delinquent tax roll and write off accounts, as appropriate; and
 - b. authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
14. Report from Parks Committee.
15. Approve letter agreement with Coles Crossing Community Association, Inc. for access to the lift station road on Jarvis Road.
16. Recreational and landscape matters, including:
 - a. proposal for debris removal;
 - b. proposal for overseeding and fertilization;
 - c. review bids and award contracts;
 - d. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate, including Coles Crossing Recreational Trail Signage project;
 - e. trail, detention and common area maintenance, signage, water fountains, and interactive fountain;
 - f. trail asphalt repair project;
 - g. fencing repairs and replacement;
 - h. Scout projects and events;
 - i. tree installation, maintenance, and removal; and
 - j. Silversand landscape maintenance matters.
17. Approve Risk and Resilience Assessment and filing of certification of same with the Environmental Protection Agency.
18. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. utility availability requests;
 - b. design, plan approval, advertisement for bids, contract award, approval of pay estimates and change orders, materials and field testing, permitting, storm water quality management plans, storm water pollution prevention plans, and other necessary actions relating to facilities, including:
 - i. sanitary sewer evaluation and rehabilitation; and
 - ii. joint wastewater treatment plant generator replacement;
 - c. feasibility study regarding potential water plant control system improvements;
 - d. deeds, easements, and encroachments, including update on North Harris County Regional Water Authority distribution and surface water lines and take appropriate action;

- e. update on conveyance of lift station no. 2 site to the District and take appropriate action;
 - f. annual review of Capital Improvement Plan;
 - g. update on request to Harris County for funding assistance for drainage/detention projects; and
 - h. other engineering matters.

 20. Maintenance and repairs to District and joint drainage and detention facilities, including:
 - a. review inspection report and approve related proposals for work; and
 - b. update on Joint Drainage Committee matters.
 21. Update on Rights of Entry for the Park at Arbordale drainage swale project and take appropriate action.
 22. Review and receive presentation regarding water rate study and, if appropriate, amend the District's Rate Order.
 23. Communication matters, including report from Communications Committee, updates to District website, and take appropriate action.
 24. Community events.
 25. Security matters, including approve Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with Harris County.
 26. District recycling service.
 27. Attorney's report, including update on Harris-Galveston Subsidence District Water Conservation School Program and, if appropriate, approve Interlocal Agreement for the District's participation in same.
 28. Discuss July 2026 meeting schedule and future agenda items.
 29. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.076, Texas Government Code, to deliberate a security audit, including the Risk and Resilience Assessment.
 30. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding the security audit, including the Risk and Resilience Assessment.
 31. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.

Comments should be directed to the entire board, not individual members. Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign, or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of time privileges.

Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 365 reserves the right to adjourn into executive session at any time during the course of this meeting to discuss any of the matters listed above, as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code §§ 551.071 (Consultation with Attorney), 551.072 (Deliberations about Real Property), 551.073 (Deliberations about Gifts and Donations), 551.074 (Personnel Matters), 551.076 (Deliberation about Security Devices), and any other provision under Texas law that permits a governmental body to discuss a matter in a closed executive session.

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
