FIRST COLONY LEVEE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS



1. Public comments.

3. Tax assessment and collection matters, including:
 - a. delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills; and
 - b. authorize delinquent tax attorney to proceed with collection of delinquent taxes.
4. MS4 Storm Water Management Plan implementation.
5. Update from Fort Bend County Commissioners Court, and update from City of Sugar Land or City of Missouri City.

7. Cybersecurity and artificial intelligence training requirements.

 - i. Safety, Monitoring and Operational Upgrades at outfall structure;
 - ii. Oyster Creek outfall closures design;
 - iii. Raise GCWA Canal; and
 - iv. Ditch "B" Channel.
12. Development Participation Agreements for Storm Sewer Outfall Improvements with City of Sugar Land and City of Missouri City.
13. Emergency action planning.
