 - b. First Amendment to Service Contract with Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc.
9. Report on development in the District.
10. Maintenance Agreement with Grand Oaks Homeowners Association.
11. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. approve pay estimates and change orders;
 - b. deeds, easements, execution of plats, consents to encroachment, conveyances, and requests for service or utility commitment letters; and
 - c. update on bond application no. 5.
