Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **WEDNESDAY, 24 JUNE 2026, at 5:00 P.M.** at the offices of Coats Rose, P.C., **9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046**, outside the boundaries of the District. The Board will consider and act upon the matters listed below.

1. Comments and questions from District residents (five-minute limit for each speaker);
2. Approval of the minutes of the meetings of 27 May and 3 June 2026;
3. Operator's Report, including:
 - (a) report on operations of the District's facilities;
 - (b) status of various repairs or replacement of equipment at District facilities;
 - (c) review actual termination list;
 - (d) correspondence from customers of the District, including requests for adjustments;
4. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) discuss matters relating to Water Supply and Groundwater Reduction Plan Wholesale Agreement (City of Houston), including status of advertisement for bids for surface water line project;
 - (b) status of water line replacement under drainage ditch serving Section 3 of Woodgate Subdivision;
 - (c) status of sanitary sewer repair along fault line;
 - (d) status of proposed Water Well 3 project;
 - (e) status of requests for service, including Werner Enterprises;
 - (f) update on other matters as needed;
5. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including:
 - (a) authorize payments from the District's tax account;
 - (b) status of collection of taxes, penalties, and interest due to the District for real and personal property accounts and consider termination of services for such accounts;
6. Bookkeeper's Report, including:
 - (a) authorize payment of the District's bills;
 - (b) review and approve Investment Report;

7. Old business, including status of survey to confirm ownership of District tracts and easements (A&S Engineers);
8. New business;
9. Attorney's Report, including status of submittal of continuing disclosure of information (deadline: 6/30/26);
10. Convene in executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, to discuss matters only relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security, if necessary;

12. Schedule future meetings as required (next meeting date is 1 July 2026).
