

**WALLER COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 35
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Monday, July 13, 2026, at 12:00 noon.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve minutes of the June 8, 2026, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Receive and act upon bids for the purchase of the District's \$13,550,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2026 (the "Bonds"), and consider taking the following actions in connection with the Bonds:
 - a. Adoption of an Order authorizing the issuance, sale and delivery of the Bonds;
 - b. Approval and distribution of Final Official Statement;
 - c. Approval and execution of Paying Agent/Registrar Agreement by and between the District and The Bank of New York Mellon Trust Company, N.A.;
 - d. Adoption of Resolution Authorizing Issuance of Notice of Redemption of the District's \$7,605,000 Bond Anticipation Note, Series 2025;
 - e. Any other matters concerning the Bonds, including the approval and execution of various documents for inclusion in the transcript of proceedings to be submitted to the Attorney General of the State of Texas; and
 - f. Engagement of auditor for preparation of audit of payments to the developer out of the proceeds of the Bonds;

Consider approval of Resolution to Comply with Securities and Exchange Commission Rule 15c2-12 and General Certificate in connection therewith: (i) Harris-Waller Counties Municipal Utility District No. 4 \$26,255,000 Contract Revenue Bonds, Series 2026, and (ii) Harris-Waller Counties Municipal Utility District No. 4 \$5,330,000 Contract Revenue Road Bonds, Series 2026;
