

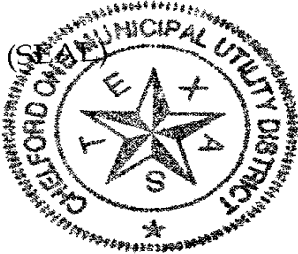
NOTICE OF MEETING

CHELFORD ONE MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT

The Board of Directors of Chelford One Municipal Utility District will hold a regular meeting on Monday, July 20, 2026, at 11:30 a.m., at Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, on the 24th Floor, in the Trinity Conference Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. District security matters, including report from On-Site Protection LLC.
4. Tax assessor/collector report, including payment of the bills on the tax account, delinquent tax collections, approval of Depository Pledge Agreements, and requests for estimates of taxable value.
5. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance;
 - b. landscape maintenance of well site tract and adjacent tracts; and
 - c. amend Rate Order, if appropriate.
6. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
7. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. authorize design, approve plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award contracts, approve pay estimates and change orders, authorize final acceptance of projects, and direct engineer to notify insurance company, as appropriate;
 - b. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service, and utility commitment letters; and
 - c. District interconnect matters, including interconnect termination agreements and related conflict waivers.
8. Mission Bend Integrated Water System matters.
9. Chelford City Regional Wastewater Treatment Plant matters.
10. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters.
11. Report on the Greater Mission Bend Area Council.
12. Mission Bend Greenbelt Association matters.
13. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including:
 - a. approval of Depository Pledge Agreements, payment of bills, and opening of bank accounts, if appropriate;
 - b. Chelford City Regional Wastewater Facility financial matters;
 - c. Mission Bend Greenbelt Authority financial matters; and
 - d. discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, approve reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.

14. Communication and website matters, including consideration of proposals and authorize appropriate action.
15. Discuss community outreach event.
