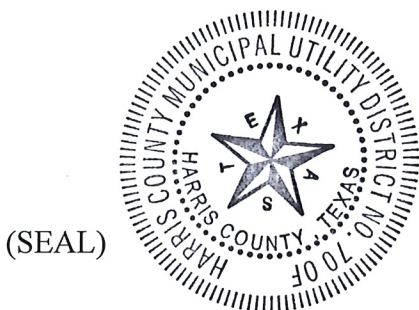
- A. Consider comments to the Joint Sewage Treatment Plant Committee portion of the June 25, 2026, Board meeting minutes;

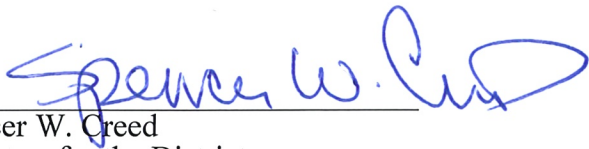
