Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 11 will hold a regular meeting, open to the public, on **WEDNESDAY, 5 AUGUST 2026, at 5:00 P.M.** at the offices of Coats Rose, P.C., **9 Greenway Plaza, Suite 1000, Houston, Texas 77046**, outside the boundaries of the District. The Board will consider and act upon the matters listed below.

1. Comments and questions from District residents (five-minute limit for each speaker);
2. Operator's Report, including:
 - (a) report on operations of the District's facilities;
 - (b) status of various repairs or replacement of equipment at District facilities;
 - (c) review actual termination list;
 - (d) correspondence from customers of the District, including requests for adjustments;
3. Report on Storm Water Detention Facilities (as needed), including approval of Amendment to Landscape Maintenance Service Agreement;
4. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) discuss matters relating to Water Supply and Groundwater Reduction Plan Wholesale Agreement (City of Houston), including status of bids for surface water line project;
 - (b) updates on other matters as needed;
5. Report regarding security matters in the District (Harris County Sheriff's Office);
6. Old business, including status of survey to confirm ownership of District tracts and easements (A&S Engineers);

7. New business, including:
 - (a) consider approval of Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with Harris County (10/1/26 to 9/30/27);
 - (b) review reports on arbitrage rebate calculation and yield restriction (Series 2016 Bonds and Series 2019 Bonds);
8. Attorney's Report, including review correspondence to Harris County Flood Control District regarding ownership of drainage ditch (Woodgate subdivision, Section 3);
9. Convene in executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, to discuss matters only relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security, if necessary;
10. Action related to matters discussed during executive session; and
11. Schedule future meetings as required (next meeting date is 26 August 2026).
