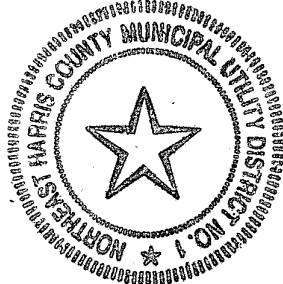
### NORTHEAST HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 1

The Board of Directors of Northeast Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 1 will hold a regular meeting on Monday, August 3, 2026, at 11:30 a.m., at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Suite 2400, Pecos Room, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Receive public comments.
