NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Friday, August 21, 2026, at 12:00 p.m.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action necessary or appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve minutes of the July 17, 2026, Board meeting;
3. Consideration and action related to resignation of Director Grzanka, including:
 - (i) Acceptance of Director Grzanka's resignation from the Board;
 - (ii) Election of Officers of the Board;
 - (iii) Approval of amended District Registration Form and update of local government officers list; and
 - (iv) Discussion regarding appointment of a new director to fill the vacancy on the Board;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector's Report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds, and approving moving of accounts to the uncollectible roll, as needed;
5. Report and legal action taken by the District's Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
6. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2026 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:
 - (i) The required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
 - (ii) The means of providing such notice;
7. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
8. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (i) Authorize the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, including approval of related storm water plans;
 - (ii) Authorize the award of or concurrence in the award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, including the approval of related

- storm water permits, and authorize acceptance of Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295, as applicable in connection therewith;
 - (iii) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and change orders, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable in connection therewith, including:
 - (a) Cleaning and televising of sanitary and storm sewer systems;
 - (iv) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes, and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295, as applicable in connection therewith;
 - (v) Status of Joint Water Plant No. 1 Rehabilitation Project by Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 276 ("MUD 276");
 - (vi) Status of installation of generator at Joint Water Plant No. 2 by MUD 276;
 - (vii) Status of Wastewater Treatment Plant Rehabilitation Project by Northwest Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 16; and
 - (viii) Status of West Little York Stormwater Detention Basin Project by Harris County Flood Control District;
9. Issuance of utility commitment(s);
10. Status of contract with Murr Incorporated in connection with landscaping of tract of land adjacent to Wastewater Treatment Plant;
11. Detention and Drainage Facilities Report by Storm Maintenance and Monitoring, Inc.; status of maintenance of tract of land adjacent to Wastewater Treatment Plant;
12. Operator's Report, including:
- (i) Authorize the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - (ii) Refer accounts for collection and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts;
 - (iii) Compliance with permits and regulatory requirements; and
 - (iv) Appeals of District charges and customer complaints, and status of collections of the District's delinquent water and sewer accounts;
13. Report by Republic Services, Inc. concerning solid waste and recycling collection activities within the District;
14. Attorney's Report, including:
- (i) Review of Annual Maintenance for Arbitrage Analysis Report prepared by Municipal Risk Management Group, LLC; authorize any action necessary in connection therewith; and
 - (ii) Authorize filing of Local Government Bond, Tax, and Project Database Report with Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts pursuant to Section 403.702, Texas Government Code;
15. Convene Executive Session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Sections 551.071 (consultation with attorney), 551.072 (deliberation regarding real property) and/or 551.076 (security matters);

16. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize any action resulting from matters discussed in Executive Session; and
17. Consideration of matters for possible placement on future agendas.
