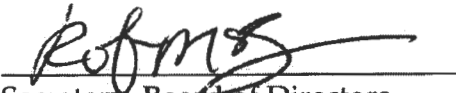
FORT BEND LEVEE COALITION MEETINGS AND UPDATES, NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM ("NFIP") LEGISLATION, FLOOD MANAGEMENT CONFERENCES, AND APPROVE ALL REIMBURSEMENTS TO DIRECTORS

The Board discussed recent emails from the Fort Bend Levee Coalition ("FBLC") regarding advocacy priorities and the potential engagement of consultants. Mr. Gill and Mr. Rozell shared questions and provided updates on their respective districts' positions. These items will be discussed further at the FBLC monthly meeting on July 9, 2026. Member districts have been asked to submit a response to FBLC by July 31, 2026. The Board agreed to provide its reply after the National Association of Flood and Stormwater Management Agencies conference scheduled for July 13-16, 2026.

ENGINEERING MATTERS

Director Coffman reported a verbal update from Greg Frank of Pape-Dawson, noting that the firm continues to prepare the bid packages for the Oyster Creek outfall closure project in coordination with both the City of Sugar Land and the City of Missouri City. No action was required, and no additional engineering matters were discussed.
