The Board of Directors of First Colony Municipal Utility District No. 10 will hold a regular meeting on Wednesday, August 12, 2026, at 12:00 p.m., at the offices of First Colony Community Services Association, 4350 Austin Parkway, Sugar Land, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Approve minutes.
3. Consider, discuss, and take appropriate action on approving a petition to rename a portion of Fluor Daniel Drive to Lake Pointe Green Drive.
4. Report regarding new development in the District and authorize appropriate action.
5. Authorize auditor to conduct audit for fiscal year end July 31, 2026.
6. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of bills and review of investments.
7. Adopt budget for fiscal year end July 31, 2027.
8. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and tax rebate payments.
9. Discuss 2026 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate.
10. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. approval of design and plans and specifications, authorize advertisement for bids, review bids and award of contract, approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance for Detention Pond to Serve Pearl Site.
11. Maintenance and repair of District facilities (FCCA) and community development projects, including:
 - a. amendment to maintenance agreement for recreational facilities; and
 - b. bulkhead repairs and tree removal and trimming.
12. Discuss Brooks Lake Trail and review plans for improvement, including:
 - a. modification of trail lights; and
 - b. camera installation matters.
13. Update on dissolution discussions with the City of Sugar Land and authorize appropriate action.
