NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on **Monday, September 14, 2026, at 12:00 noon.**

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Review and approve minutes of the August 10, 2026, Board of Directors meeting, and amendment to the minutes of the August 12, 2024 Board of Directors meeting;
3. Review and approve audit for fiscal year ended May 31, 2026, and authorize execution of Annual Filing Affidavit in connection therewith;
4. Approval of supplemental audit of payments to developer out of the proceeds of the District's \$13,550,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2026; authorize disbursement of funds in accordance therewith; adoption of Resolution Authorizing Use of Surplus Construction Funds and Interest Earned on Construction Funds;
5. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2026 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:
 - a. the required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
 - b. the means of providing such notice;
6. Tax Assessor-Collector Report;
7. Report and legal action taken by the District's Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney;
8. Operator's Report, including:
 - a. Authorize the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - b. Appeal of District charges and customer complaints, and status of collections of the District's delinquent water and sewer accounts; refer accounts for collections and approve write-off of uncollectible accounts; and
 - c. Compliance with permit and regulatory requirements, including discussion of any violations of same and review of notices of violation, self-reporting of any violations as required, responses to notices and remedial action taken, self-reporting forms as required, and correspondence to and from regulatory agencies regarding same;
