

NOTICE OF MEETING

RENN ROAD MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT OF HARRIS AND FORT BEND COUNTIES, TEXAS

The Board of Directors of Renn Road Municipal Utility District of Harris and Fort Bend Counties, Texas, will hold a regular meeting on Friday, September 4, 2026, at 12:30 p.m., at the offices of Vogler & Spencer Engineering, Inc., 777 North Eldridge Parkway, Suite 500, Conference Room A, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Approve minutes.
2. Public comments.
3. Engage auditor to conduct audit for the District and of the regional sewage treatment plant for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.
4. Garbage collection and recycling matters.
5. Security and patrol matters, including financial contributions for security services from District Homeowners Associations, discuss security upgrades and recommendations, and authorize appropriate action.
6. Discuss Flock Camera contract renewal and authorize appropriate action.
7. Report on mowing and detention pond maintenance and authorization of work orders and proposals, as appropriate, and graffiti removal matters.
8. Financial and bookkeeping matters, payment of the bills, and review of investments.
9. Adopt budget for the District's fiscal year ending September 30, 2027.
10. Adopt budget for Sewage Treatment Plant for the fiscal year end September 30, 2027.
11. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, payment of tax bills, and delinquent tax report.
12. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent tax accounts and authorize termination of service.
13. Discuss 2026 tax rate, set public hearing date, and authorize notice of public hearing regarding adoption of tax rate.
14. Operation of District facilities, including:
 - a. billings, repairs and maintenance;
 - b. review and update 5-Year Capital Improvements Repair and Maintenance Plan;
 - c. hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers, authorize termination of service; and
 - d. amendment of Rate Order, if applicable.

15. Discuss streetlight project along Eldridge and authorize appropriate action.
16. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. update on West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters;
 - b. wastewater treatment plant facilities, repairs, clarifier rehabilitation project, and permit renewals;
 - c. Fort Bend and Harris County mobility projects;
 - d. deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, requests for service or utility capacity commitment letters, and development financing agreements; and
 - e. other engineering matters, including:
 - i. Renn Road Wastewater Treatment Facilities Improvements;
 - ii. Huber Step Screen and Wash Press Rehabilitation;
 - iii. Storm Sewer Clean and Rehabilitation project – Keegans Wood Sections 1-3, Oakbend Forest Section 1, and Sugarfield Sections 1 and 2; and
 - iv. Water Plant No. 1 Conversion from Chlorine Gas to Liquid Bleach.
17. Annexation matters, including annexation requests, letter agreements and annexation feasibility report.
18. Storm water management plan and storm water permitting matters, receive public comment, training, review stormwater guidance manual, discuss Stormwater Speaker Series, and authorize appropriate action.
19. Kingsbridge Municipal Utility District, West Keegans Bayou Improvement District, West Harris County Regional Water Authority, and regional municipal meeting matters.
20. Annual report to Bond Review Board.
21. Discuss items to be included on next agenda.
