

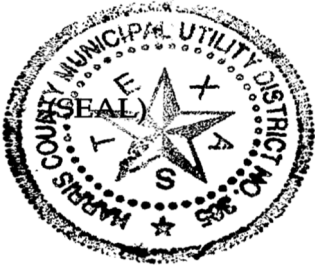
NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 365

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 365 will hold a special meeting on **Tuesday, September 8, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.**, at 13050 Barker Cypress Road, Cypress, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comment.*
2. Approve minutes.
3. District recycling and household hazardous waste services, including consider proposal for curbside collection of household hazardous waste and approve amendment to contract with Best Trash, LLC, if appropriate.
4. Engineering and operating matters, including:
 - a. update on NHCRWA surface water line projects;
 - b. approve proposals for supplemental engineering services and related agreements;
 - c. update on request to Harris County for funding assistance for drainage/detention projects; and
 - d. other engineering matters.
5. Water conservation and drainage matters, including update on Coles Crossing Stormwater Detention and Water Quality Improvement Project.
6. Community events, including consider contribution requests and take appropriate action.
7. Communication matters, including report from Communications Committee, updates to District website, and take appropriate action.
8. Security matters, including discuss staffing matters and authorize appropriate action.
9. Park matters, including report from Parks Committee and take appropriate action.
10. Recreational and landscape matters, including:
 - a. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance, as appropriate, including Coles Crossing Recreational Trail Signage project;
 - b. trail, projects, detention and common area maintenance, signage, water fountains, and interactive fountain;
 - c. fencing repairs and replacement;
 - d. Scout projects and events;
 - e. tree installation, maintenance, and removal;
 - f. proposal for overseeding and fertilization;
 - g. request from homeowners association for installation of access barriers on District property;
 - h. District trail asphalt repair project; and
 - i. Silversand landscape maintenance matters.

11. Update on potential conveyance of park tracts and take appropriate action.
12. Convene in Executive Session pursuant to Section 551.072, Texas Government Code, to deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.
13. Reconvene in Open Session and authorize appropriate action regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property.
