The Board will consider and act upon the matters listed below.

1. Comments and questions from District residents (five-minute limit for each speaker);

 - (b) status of various repairs or replacement of equipment at District facilities;
 - (c) review actual termination list;
 - (d) correspondence from customers of the District, including requests for adjustments;
3. Report on Storm Water Detention Facilities (as needed), including approval of Amendment to Landscape Maintenance Service Agreement;
4. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) status of construction of surface water line (AR TurnKee Construction Company, Inc.);
 - (b) updates on other matters, as needed;
5. Report regarding security matters in the District (Harris County Sheriff's Office);
6. Old business;

7. New business, including:
 - (a) consider tax rate recommendation from the District's Financial Advisor;
 - (b) schedule public hearing on proposed 2026 tax rate and authorize publication of notice of hearing;
8. Attorney's Report, including status of proposed real estate transactions relating to Reserve H of Maple Ridge Place Subdivision, Section 2, and authorize actions deemed necessary;
9. Convene in executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Chapter 551, to discuss matters only relating to pending or contemplated litigation, personnel matters, real estate transactions, or security, if necessary;
10. Action related to matters discussed during executive session; and
11. Schedule future meetings as required (next meeting date is 23 September 2026).
